- Basic computer knowledge (simple training provided)
- 13+ years of age

OVERVIEW

Our teen helpers are the energetic faces in our Kids' Ministry. They're not just helpers; they're essential members of our team! SET-UP + STRIKE TEAM

OVERVIEW

This team makes Sunday morning possible! Members of our set-up & strike team do the work of preparing the gym for worship, and returning it back to status quo after the service. We set up and tear down drapes, chairs, tables, church signage, A/V equipment, everything on the stage, etc. It's a big task, and one that takes plenty of people to accomplish.

FREQUENCY

1-2 times a month

Set-up (before the Sunday service) from 7:00 am - 7:45 am

Strike (after the Sunday service) from 11:00 am - 11:45 am

REQUIREMENTS

- Physical ability (for some of the tasks)

SET-UP & STRIKE

ROAD SIGNS DELIVERY

OVERVIEW

We always want first-time guests to be able to find Wellspring easily on a Sunday morning — that's why we set up clear signage around Trivium every weekend. On Saturday mornings, we need people to deliver and set up three signs (which are kept in our storage truck at Skyway Church) around the intersections close to Trivium Prep. On Sunday afternoons (after the service but before 7:00 pm), we take down the signs and load them into our storage truck at Skyway.

FREQUENCY

1-2 times a month; the signs need to be set up on Saturday mornings and removed on Sunday afternoons. This task shouldn't take more than 30 minutes total.

- Access to a truck or SUV (those signs are big!)

LIVE STREAM & CAMERA OPERATOR

OVERVIEW

We're glad to provide an online option for those who are traveling, unable to attend the service in person, or are checking out Wellspring for the very first time. Our live stream operator monitors the live stream to ensure everything is working properly. This task involves monitoring video and audio, and making adjustments as needed.

FREQUENCY

1-2 times a month

- Some familiarity with cameras / video
